There is one heading that you do not need. **1** The Netherlands is only a small country in the north of Europe, but it attracts huge numbers of tourists every year. Visitors are interested in the landscapes, culture, and heritage of the country, and want to experience the famous, relaxed attitude of Dutch people to life in general. The only problem is that too many people are now visiting the country, which is causing problems with transport, accommodation, and overcrowding. One famous, small village that only has 2,500 inhabitants is visited by 350,000 tourists every year – and that's only the Chinese tourists. **2** So what can be done about the problem? Both national and local governments in the Netherlands are now looking at ways to limit the number of guests. It's not that they want to stop tourism altogether, they just want to get it under control. This may be a little controversial, especially with local businesspeople, whose firms rely on a continuous stream of customers. They will probably have to accept the changes, however, as a lot of Dutch people are now unhappy with the situation. **3** One of the ways the government is looking into is to restrict the number of beds available to tourists in a particular town or city. This would mean that potential visitors would not find rooms for rent online or through travel agencies, and would therefore be unable to stay in specific locations. Another possible idea is to raise prices for certain attractions, although the number of wealthy people travelling abroad is increasing all the time. **4** A more radical option might be to make it physically more difficult to spend time in certain locations. To do this, electronic gates can be installed at the entrance to old town squares or particularly attractive areas. The number of people within this zone would therefore be limited to a maximum decided upon by the local authorities. The destruction of buildings and monuments would be prevented, and the visiting experience would be nicer for all. **5** Whatever methods are used, something has to be done quite quickly to prevent popular landmarks becoming theme parks. One local person expressed this by saying that it no longer felt pleasant living in a place that was like a museum. After all, modern day life still has to go on, and we can't expect local residents to dress and behave as if they were living two hundred years ago.
